## SOCIAL WORKERS APPLAUD OUR WORK



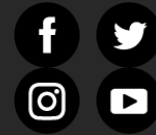
On March 7, the Fairfax County Public Schools Office of Social Work Services gave Alice's Kids their "Community Partner Award."
