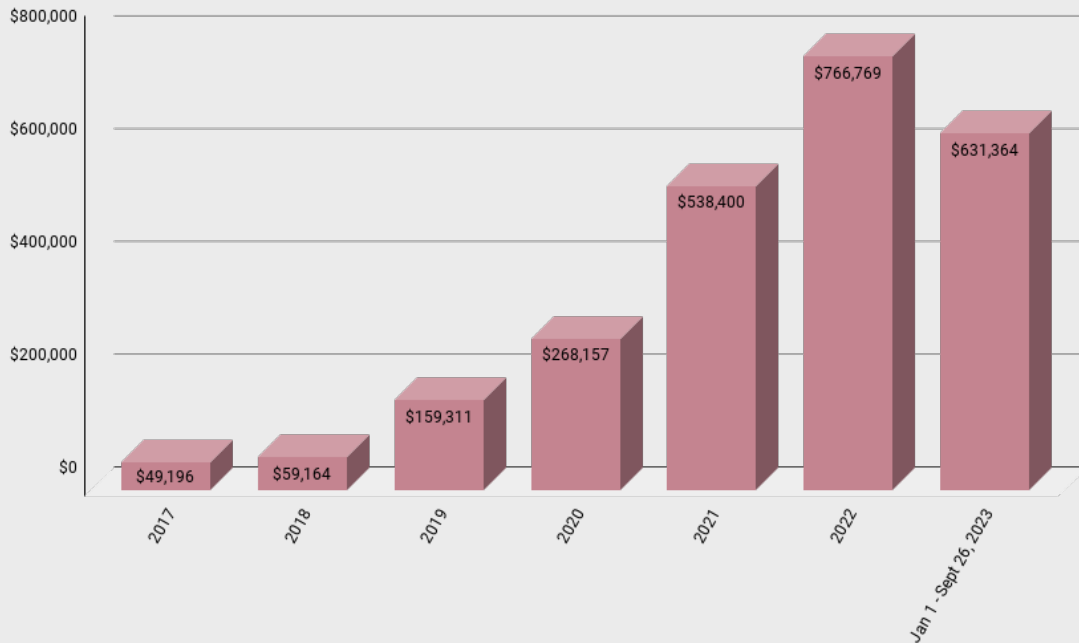

He then took a moment to tell the crowd how we are his "favorite charity" and recounted how he had won \$250,000 for us on Celebrity Jeopardy. It was a great night.

IMPACT

"I wanted you to know that ever since the kiddos were able to get new clothing, there has been a complete 180 in their behavior. They used to really struggle with hygiene and isolation. They have been very proactive about taking care of their new laundry, needing little to no reminders. They have also been asking to join in community outings, something very new for them. They have been attending field trips with our children's program and asking to go for walks, to the lake, etc. The impact this gift has had on them is monumental. Thank you so much for what you have done."

IN ADDITION TO THE USUAL REQUESTS, IN SEPTEMBER WE PAID FOR...

A "Wobbly Stool" for a 5-year-old boy who can become aggressive when he is dysregulated.

Cheerleading fees for a 9-year-old girl whose home life has had many traumas.

Acting classes for a 5-year-old girl whose parents are separated and whose mom is struggling to stretch her income. This provides an outlet for the girl who loves acting and singing as well as a safe place to be after school.

Home weights and workout equipment for 17-year-old brothers who live with retired grandparents. The brothers have been assaulted and robbed twice recently and need to avoid working out at the community rec center for safety.

A cold water wetsuit for a 16-year-old boy who is on his high school's surf club/team. He works part time as his Dad is unemployed and waiting on disability benefits.
